from the beginning of the game score very fast, and in this case the only way to "Cover Up" is by giving long odds against your original favorites.

"MUTUAL BETS", OR "PARI MUTUEL"

There are also sold in the lobby, before the "Matches", "Mutual Bets", tickets at \$5.00 Mexican currency.

A black board in the lobby shows names of the players, number, of point the Match is to be played, and after the sale is closed, the number of "Mutual Bets" tickets sold on each side. At the end of the game the same board indicates the amount paid to each winning ticket.

QUINIELAS

"Quiniela" is a Basque word meaning "Lottery", and as in any game of chance luck plays the principal part.

Each player a number, which is shown on the score board alongside his name. Before the "Quiniela" starts lots are drawn to determine the order of play.

The game is an elimination contest, the first eliminated going back into play after others have lost, etc., in the manner of a "Round Robin" until one of the players score six points, thereby becoming the winner. In order to win one must have a ticket with two numbers pertaining to two of the six players. One of which must be the number of the winner and the other number of the player, which is the player with the next highest score. In case two or more players have the same number of points for the second place, the first to have scored them is placed.

There are in all fifteen combinations, as follows.

1-2, 1-3, 1-4, 1-5, 1-6; 2-3, 2-4, 2-5, 2-6, 3-4, 3-5, 3-6; 4-5, 4-6 and 5-6.

Tickets for "Quinielas" may be bought in the lobby at windows with signs telling the combinations sold at each window. Each ticket costs \$5.00

The total number of ticket sold is shown on a black board in the lobby after the sale is closed.

In order to compute the value of each winning ticket, the total value of non-winning tickets minus the percentage charged by the house for the sale, is distributed among the winners. The value of each winning ticket is also shown on the black board after the "Quiniela" has been played.
